**FREEDOM OF INFORMATION
AND PROTECTION OF PRIVACY ACT**

you can:



SEE OR GET A COPY OF RECORDS

(general information) held by public bodies, and any refusal must be justified



SEE OR GET A COPY OF YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

held by public bodies, and request a correction if you believe there is an error



MAKE A COMPLAINT TO THE OMBUDSMAN

about any access decision made by the public body or about how your access request was handled



DESIGNATE ANOTHER PERSON

to exercise your rights or make a complaint on your behalf
